




Considering how environmental factors impact usability

Adjustable Audio


Sounds at or below 80 dB are considered safe for our hearing. Around 60 dB is equivalent to a normal conversation between two people. Home technologies should have adjustable volume, with the initial setting around 60dB.





Environmental Impact

Environmental factors such as lighting levels, ambient sounds, and weather conditions can impact users' ability to conduct a test.
